RESOLUTION

3
In reference to Government of India D.O. letter L-19017/1/2008-UH (Volume-III) dated 17.05.2013, National Urban Health Mission (NUHM) is being launched as a sub-mission of the National Health Mission (NHM) for taking care of the primary health care needs of the urban population, with focus on the Urban Poor. National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) will be the other sub-mission of the National Health Mission (NHM).

2. National Urban Health Mission (NUHM) is being launched in all cities/towns with a population of more than 50,000; all district headquarters (DHQ) and the State capital. Towns with a population below 50,000 will be covered under the National Rural Health Mission (NRHM).
3. NUHM aims to improve the health status of urban population, particularly the slum dwellers and other vulnerable sections by facilitating equitable access to quality health care with the active involvement of Urban Local Bodies (ULBs). It proposes to achieve its objectives by developing appropriate public health delivery system across cities/towns with provisions for creating new infrastructure where none exists, strengthening the existing primary public health systems, entering into partnership with for-profit and not-for-profit private sector, improving access and building community capacity through community level institutions like "**Mahila Arogya Samiti (MAS)**" and link workers called "**Accredited Social Health Activists (ASHA)**", capacity building of key stakeholders like ULBs and by making special provision for inclusion of the most vulnerable amongst the poor.
4. The National Urban Health Mission would use the institutional structures already created under NRHM at State level, Divisional and District levels for operationalisation of the NUHM, as a sub-mission of NHM.
5. However, in order to provide dedicated focus to issues relating to urban health, institutional mechanism under the NRHM at various levels would be strengthened for NUHM implementation. The existing Governance structure and financial mechanisms existing under the NRHM would also serve NUHM.
 - i. At the State level, in the State Health Mission (SHM) under the Hon. Chief Minister, UP will also include the Minister of Minority Affairs and Minister of Education as members of existing SHM.
 - ii. The Governing Body of State Health Society (SHS) under the Chief Secretary, GoUP will also include the Principal Secretaries of Minority Affairs and Education as members of existing GB.

- iii. The Executive Committee under Principal Secretary, Medical Health and Family Welfare, GoUP will also include the Director, Minority Affairs and Education as members of existing EC.
- iv. State Programme Management Unit (SPMU) under Mission Director will be responsible for providing overall guidance and taking important decisions.
6. At District/City level activities of NUHM will be implemented by existing District Health Society with additional Stakeholders members such as DUDA.
7. NRHM & NUHM would be the two components of the National Health Mission (NHM). Mission Director, National Rural Health Mission would be Mission Director, National Health Mission, comprising both the sub-missions NRHM and NUHM.
8. Operational guideline for Financial Management, GoI, adopted by Governing Body of State Health Society, shall apply to the activities under National Urban Health Mission.
